


Network Infrastructure for SENSORS

Possible Network Infra for Sensors



Closure of 2G Networks Frees up spectrum for 3G+4G

Existing 2G networks to closed by April 2017 2G subscriptions only make up <2% of all mobile subscriptions

Good 3G and 4G coverage in Singapore

- **3G** >**99%** nationwide outdoor coverage
- 4G >99% nationwide outdoor coverage

MNOs to facilitate transition by:

- Maintaining 2G subscription existing service ٠ plans on 3G network (no increase in fees)
- **Low-cost 3G phones** (no contract required) available for <\$\$100
- IDA, CASE and MNOs raise awareness by advertisements, social media and outreach programmes.



To 4G and Beyond


- **4G is the new normal** 52% of all mobile subscriptions in Singapore are 4G
- 5G commercial trials by 2020
- Singapore has one of the world's highest smartphone penetration rates : 9 out of every 10 surveyed users have smartphones (Deloitte, 2015)

Affordability of Fibre Broadband spurring migration from older technologies

- **1Gbps fibre broadband plan (\$39/month)** one of the most affordable in the world prices have fallen by more than 90% since January 2014.
- 10Gbps residential fibre broadband now available using either Optical Ethernet or xGPON technology. Prices from \$189/month
