Transportation Options

The Sheraton Dallas Hotel is located downtown across from the DART Rail Pearl Station, which serves all lines. The hotel has valet and self-parking facilities (Conference Rate is \$10).

Love Field Public Transportation. Take bus route 39 from the terminal to the Inwood/Love Field Station on the DART Rail Green Line. Take DART Rail to Pearl Station. The combined fare is \$1.75 each way.

DFW Airport Public Transportation. Take the Remote South shuttle bus from the terminal to the Remote South Lot and connect to the bus to the Trinity Railway Express (TRE) CentrePort/DFW Airport station. Take the TRE train to downtown Dallas Victory Station and connect to the DART Rail Green Line to Pearl Station. The TRE operates Monday through Saturday. The combined fare is \$3.50 each way.

SuperShuttle. For either airport, use Group/Discount code C43GS. You must book and prepay to receive the discount. The fare is \$16 one way or \$30 round-trip (normally \$18 and \$36), driver gratuity excluded.
