The Difference between Relief and Development

	Relief	Development
Required Situation	Disaster, Life & Death Situation	Normal life – people want to improve
Duration	Short-term	Long-term
Source of Resources	Bring outside resources	Maximize use of local resources
Ownership/Game Plan	Outsider	Local people
End result	May create dependency, exhaustion	Creates sustainability, independence
Type of Action	Doing things FOR people, reactive, curative	Empowering, teaching people to do it themselves, pro-active prevention
