



## Instructions for POSTER Presentations

**2019 Annual Conference - March 26-29, 2019**

### Schedule and Location of Poster Sessions

The final schedule for poster presentations can be found in the online program on the main conference website. Links for the Overview, Meeting at-a-Glance, and Full Final Program are available.

Poster numbers will be available on the conference website in the Full Final Program on or before February 10, 2019. *Please note your poster number as it is the location of your poster display board.*

There are 2 poster sessions with expected attendance by presenters:

- **Attended Poster Session #1 - Odd:** Wednesday from 10:00am – noon (odd numbered poster presenters)
- **Attended Poster Session #2 - Even:** Thursday from 10:00am – noon (even numbered poster presenters)

At least one author should be available to talk with attendees during the assigned poster session. It is not expected that presenters be at their poster outside of their assigned time.

All poster sessions will be held in room *Frisco 6*, in the same room as the exhibit hall and vendor space.

### Poster Dimensions

Both general posters and thematic posters should comply with these instructions. Total space for your poster is **48 x 48 inches**, therefore recommended size is smaller (such as 46 by 46 inches) or 48 inches wide x 36 inches high for a landscape orientation. Please note that this is the available area and that your poster does not need to fill it completely. For example, your poster could be as large as 36" wide and 48" in height (portrait orientation) or 48" wide and 36" in height (landscape orientation). Most common is a 4x3 ratio landscape orientation with a width less than 48".

Push-pins will be available at the poster boards. Additional materials will be available at the Registration Desk. You can include business cards, printed copies of your poster, or supporting

information on the area allocated to your poster if you wish; but it is not required. All unclaimed posters will be discarded after the conference ends.

Posters must be hung by:	Tues 3/26/19 5:00pm
Posters must hang until:	Thurs 3/28/19 4:00pm
Posters must be removed by:	Thurs 3/28/19 6:00pm

We encourage you to hang up posters as soon as possible to provide the attendees with adequate time to view your poster.
