

Wisconsin State Agencies

- **Wisconsin Department of Corrections (DOC) – Madison, WI**

The Wisconsin Department of Corrections is the largest state agency and operates 36 adult institutions and facilities with 10,000 employees statewide. DOC is responsible for the safe and humane custody of 22,000 inmates in prisons and correctional centers and the supervision of 68,000 adult offenders on court-ordered probation, parole or extended supervision in the community. DOC is also responsible for about 500 juveniles committed by the courts to secure state juvenile facilities or community supervision. A variety of other programs and offices support the DOC's public safety mission, which includes providing support and services to crime victims.

The Department of Corrections purchases a wide range commodities and services of all types including janitorial, psychological, electrical, repair, food, and others.

- **Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) – Purchasing – Madison, WI**

WISDOT purchases clothing/uniforms, training, general commodities/services, IT software/hardware, not related to Chapter 84 (Not related to state and federal highway improvements).

- **Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs (DMA) – Madison, WI**

The Department of Military Affairs (DMA) provides essential, effective, and responsive military and emergency management capability for the citizens of our state and nation. DMA includes Joint Force Headquarters-Wisconsin, the Wisconsin Army and Air National Guard, and the Wisconsin Division of Emergency Management. DMA purchases a wide variety of services and commodities which include Janitorial services, lawn mowing services, snowplowing services, bus transportation services, screen printing, building repair, remodeling, electrical, and plumbing.

- **Wisconsin Department of Revenue (DOR) – Madison, WI**

The Department of Revenue administers the state's major tax laws, including the collection of individual income taxes, sales taxes, corporate income taxes and excise taxes. The Department purchases a variety of goods and services including office supplies, printers, copiers, ink, toner, paper, computer accessories, software, and training programs.

- **Wisconsin Department of Children and Families – Madison, WI**

The Wisconsin Department of Children and Families works to ensure that all children are safe in their own homes, And, when that cannot be assured, that they are provided a safe and loving foster or adoptive home. The Department also works to ensure that children have access to health care, both physical and mental health; that they are well-educated; and that families are getting stronger as a result of being involved in our child welfare system.

The Department purchases the following goods including, furniture and furnishings, financial services, consulting services, construction services, general hardware, cleaning services, printing services, security services, and social welfare services.

- **Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development (DWD) Office of Procurement – Madison, WI**

The Department's primary responsibilities include providing job services, training and employment assistance to people looking for work, while at the same time working with employers on finding the necessary workers to fill current job openings. Under the DWD umbrella, a wide variety of employment programs can be found which range from securing jobs for people with disabilities, assisting former welfare recipients as they make a transition into work, promoting employment in the state through Wisconsin Job Centers, linking youth with jobs of tomorrow, protecting and enforcing worker's rights, processing unemployment claims and ensuring workers compensation claims are paid in accordance with the law. They are looking for companies that can provide grant writing, program auditing, training, and janitorial services.

- **Wisconsin Department of Administration (DOA) – Madison, WI**

Department of Administration supports other state agency's programs by offering services such as centralized purchasing. The agency is looking for businesses that can provide a wide range of requirements including insurance, brokerage, catering, and IT services.

- **University of Wisconsin Madison - Purchasing Services – Madison, WI**

University of Wisconsin Madison Purchasing services provides the University with products and services using effective and responsive life cycle procurement practices. As an institution of higher education UW-Madison purchases products and services in almost every imaginable sector. However, they are required to use the mandatory state (Department of Administration) contracts (IT, MRO, Office Supplies etc.). The University is committed to the promotion of MBE's and has a goal of 5% of their total procurement dollars targeted to certified MBE's.

- **University of Wisconsin System – Madison, WI**

The University of Wisconsin System is one of the largest systems of public higher education in the country, serving approximately 180,000 students each year and employing more than 39,000 faculty and staff statewide. The UW System is made up of 13 four-year universities, 13 freshman-sophomore UW Colleges campuses, and statewide UW-Extension and has an annual budget of \$6 billion dollars. The University of Wisconsin System purchases a wide range of products to operate campuses, such as maintenance and repair items, cleaning services, computers and other technology services.
