Federal Agencies

US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) - Region 5 Chicago, IL

The mission of EPA is to protect human health and the environment. Region 5 is responsible for the states of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio, and Wisconsin. Areas of interest include, information technology, environmental remediation management, scientific technical consulting, and environmental consulting.

• US General Services Administration (GSA) – Region 5 Chicago, IL

GSA employs about 12,000 federal workers and has an annual operating budget of roughly \$26.3 billion. GSA oversees \$66 billion in procurement annually supporting other Federal agencies. GSA administers a wide variety of purchasing programs including GSA schedules, technology programs, fleet and automotive, travel programs, and many others. They also administer the US Department of Veterans Affairs Federal Supply Schedule program.

US General Services Administration (GSA) Public Buildings Service (PBS) – Region 5 Chicago, IL

PBS contributes to the management of about \$500 billion in U.S. federal property including 9,600 owned and leased buildings. Types of properties include land, office buildings, warehouses, former post offices, farms, family residences, and air fields. Areas of responsibility include design and construction, facilities management, historic preservation, environmental programs, energy programs, and reality services.

US Department of Veterans Affairs - Great Lakes Acquisition Center (GLAC) VISN-12 Milwaukee, WI

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs VISN 12 consists of hospitals located in Chicago, Hines, Milwaukee, Madison, Tomah, and Iron Mountain, MI as well outpatient clinics and other facilities. The VA spends over \$17 billion annually. The US Department of Veterans Affairs provides patient care and federal benefits to veterans and their dependents. As one of the largest Federal Agencies, VA Procures a large range of supplies and services for their healthcare facilities including, medical supplies and equipment, IT equipment and services, other critical patient care items and construction.

US Coast Guard Lake Michigan Sector (USCG) – Milwaukee, WI

Coast Guard Sector Lake Michigan is comprised of 21 Coast Guard Stations/Units that are responsible for 1,638 miles of shoreline and approximately 19,000 square miles of surface water. The Area of Responsibility for Sector Lake Michigan includes jurisdiction in four states: Wisconsin, Illinois, Indiana, and Michigan; in addition to the majority of Lake Michigan and numerous intercostal waterways.
