



Hat sized for preemie (infant, toddler, child). Shown in child size.

MATERIALS

- 1 ball each of desired worsted-weight yarn in the following colors:

Boys'

- burgundy (A), blue (B), light blue (C) and ecru (D)

Girls'

- merlot (A), fuchsia (B), rose (C) and ecru (D)
- One pair size 8 (5mm) needles, OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- One size 8 (5mm) circular needle, 16 (20, 20, 24)"/40 (50, 50, 60cm) long
- Crochet hook for attaching fringe
- Stitch marker

MEASUREMENTS

- **Scarf:** 7"/18cm (slightly stretched) x 53½"/136cm (before fringe)
- ***Hat circumference** 10 (12, 14, 15½)"/25.5 (30.5, 35.5, 39.5)cm

***Note** Hat will stretch to fit.

GAUGE

24 sts and 21 rows = 4"/10cm over k2, p2 rib (slightly stretched) using size 8 (5mm) needles.

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STRIPE PATTERN FOR SCARF

20 rows A, 10 rows B, 5 rows C, 20 rows D, 10 rows A, 5 rows B, 20 rows C, 10 rows D, 5 rows A, 20 rows B, 10 rows C, 5 rows D. Rep these 140 rows for Stripe Pattern.

striped hat & scarf set

Both pieces in this coordinated set get an extra something to play up the stripe pattern—long fringe for the muffler, a big peppered pom-pom for the hat.

SCARF

With straight needles and A, cast on 42 sts. Working in Stripe Pattern, work in k2, p2 rib as follows:

Row 1 (RS) *K2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, end k2.

Row 2 (WS) *P2, k2; rep from * to last 2 sts, end p2.

Rep rows 1 and 2 for k2, p2 rib.

Work 140 rows of Stripe Pattern twice—280 rows in total, or to desired length.

Bind off in rib.

FINISH THE SCARF

Cut fourteen 13"/33cm strands in each color. Make 14 bunches containing one strand of each color. With crochet hook, make 7 fringes evenly spaced along cast-on and bound-off edges. Trim evenly.

HAT

With circular needle and A, cast on 60 (72, 84, 92) sts. Place marker and join for knitting in the round. Work in k2, p2 rib in stripes as follows: 10 (10, 15, 20) rows A, 5 (10, 10, 10) rows B, 5 rows C. Hat should measure approx 4 (4¾, 5¾, 6½)"/10 (12, 14.5, 16.5)cm from beg. Change to D, and work one rnd even.

Next (dec) rnd *K2, p2tog; rep from * to end—45 (54, 63, 69) sts. **Next 2 (3, 4, 5) rnds** *K2, p1; rep from * to end. **Next (dec) rnd** *K2tog, p1; rep from * to end—30 (36, 42, 46) sts. **Next rnd** *K1, p1; rep from * to end. **Next (dec) rnd** *K2tog; rep from * to end—15 (18, 21, 23) sts.

Cut yarn with 6"/15cm tail, thread through rem sts and cinch tightly to close. With 1 strand of each color, make a 4"/10cm pom-pom and secure to top of hat. ■

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rib and garter baby hat

A sweet little cap for kids of all sizes, from preemies up to bigger kids. Wide ribbing followed by garter stitch adds dimension to this simple knit.



Sized for preemie (infant, toddler, child). Shown in preemie size.

MATERIALS

- 1 ball of desired DK-weight yarn
- One pair size 6 (4mm) needles, OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- Two size 6 (4mm) dpn for I-cord top

MEASUREMENTS

- **Head circumference** 12½ (14½, 16½, 18)"/31.5 (37, 42, 45.5)cm
- **Length** approx 4 (4½, 4½, 5)"/10 (11.5, 11.5, 12.5)cm

GAUGE

22 sts = 4"/10cm over garter st using size 6 (4mm) needles.

TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

BRIM

Cast on 68 (80, 92, 98) sts.

Row 1 (RS) *P2, k4; rep from *, end p2.

Row 2 *K2, p4; rep from *, end k2.

Rep rows 1 and 2 rows for rib until piece measures 1½"/4cm from beg.

BODY

Work in garter st (k every row) for 2½ (3, 3, 3½)"/6.5 (7.5, 7.5, 8.5)cm.

Shape crown

Dec row 1 (RS) K1, [k2tog] 33 (39, 45, 48) times, k1—35 (41, 47, 50) sts.

Knit 1 row.

Dec row 2 (RS) K1 (1, 1, 0), [k2tog] 17 (20, 23, 25) times—18 (21, 24, 25) sts.

Knit 1 row.

Next row K1 (k3tog, 0, k3tog), [k2tog] 8 (9, 12, 11) times, k1 (0, 0, 0)—10 (10, 12, 12) sts.

Next row (WS) [K2tog] 5 (5, 3, 3) times, [k3tog] 0 (0, twice, twice)—5 sts.

Cord top

Change to dpn and work I-cord as foll:

***Next row (RS)** K5, do *not* turn work. Slide sts to beg of needle to work next row from RS.

Rep from * until I-cord measures 1"/2.5cm.

Last row Pass the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th st over the first st. Fasten off last st.

FINISHING

Sew back seam. Weave in ends. ■
