Hosted by Bangkok Dusit Medical Services (BDMS) at the Samitivej Srinakarin Hospital, this roadshow attracted >120 attendees from 20 unique organizations in Thailand. The roadshow was followed by a 3-hour EMRAM workshop conducted by John Daniels, CNM, FACHE, FHIMSS, CPHIMS, Global Vice President, Healthcare Advisory Services Group, HIMSS Analytics.

The roadshow opened with a welcome address from Dr. Mike McCoy, CMIO, BDMS and a power panel discussion titled **Establishing Standards for the Collection of Data and Analysis to Generate Intelligent Clinical Outcomes: Challenges and Breakthroughs in Thailand.**

Panelists shared about the challenges they faced with data analysis from the private and public perspectives. Key challenges included data silos, change management and benefits realization.

After the morning networking tea break, Dr. Mike McCoy, CMIO, BDMS and Dr. James Miser, CMIO Bumrungrad International took the stage to share case studies on how their organizations are embracing technology and leveraging data analytics to improve care outcomes. The roadshow concluded with a presentation from Prof. Dr. Wasun Chantratita, Head of Medical Genome Center, Ramathibodi Hospital, Mahidol University on success stories in genomic medicine in Thailand. Dr. Wasun is currently partnering with TCELS to advance projects such as the Pharmacogenomics project, fast becoming the blueprint for the future of personalized medicine for Thailand.

This roadshow enabled us to re-connect with our Thai audience and to introduce HIMSS ASiaPac16, which will be held in Bangkok come August 2016.

Held at Queen Sirikit National Convention Centre in Bangkok, this well-received event attracted 70+ attendees and speakers, including the senior management team at HIMSS.

HIMSS President and Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Steve Lieber, gave the opening introduction and welcome address. During his introduction, Steve shared about the HIMSS Value Suite and how EMRAM adoption can drive IT procurement, seamless integration and both clinical and commercial outcomes in a structured manner.

Dr. Choosna Makarasarn, President of the Thai Medical Informatics Association (TMI) shared insights into the IT adoption situation in Thailand. Chief Medical Informatics Officers (CMIOs) are still far and few between; Associate Professor Low Cheng Ooi, Chief Medical Informatics Officer, MOH Holdings and Ministry of Health Singapore shared about Singapore's experience from the perspective of a CMIO.

A/Prof Low discussed the silo-ed strategies from clinical and technical healthcare professionals and emphasized that both CIOs/CTOs and CMIOs need to be aligned when implementing IT, to ensure that the solutions are technically sound but clinician-friendly for optimal commercial and clinical outcomes to be achieved.

Dr. Boonchai Kijsanayotin MD., PhD AeHIN Co-chair, Thai Health Information Standards Development Center (THIS), Health Systems Research Institute, Ministry of Public Health (MOPH), Thailand gave a critical presentation on capacity building and IT adoption challenges and successes in Thailand.

We were also delighted to have the CMIO of Bumrungrad International, Dr. James Miser share about Bumrungrad's efforts with IBM-Watson to create seamless IT innovations for top notch healthcare delivery outcomes. Last but not least, Dr. Manish Kohli, Chief, Medical Informatics, Cleveland Clinic (Abu Dhabi) discussed about leveraging carepathways and technologies to deliver world-class care.
