ČESKÝ KRUMLOV, the town that reaches to the skies above a bend on the River Vltava, Český Krumlov is a pearl of Renaissance architecture and a place where the sumptuousness of the local castle, maze-like alleyways, richly decorated coats of arms of burghers houses, and wonderful floral gardens are harmoniously interwoven; at the same time, it boasts medieval pubs, ale-houses, galleries and graphite mines.

In the afternoon the visit of Cesky Krumlov chateau and castle including visit of Baroque theatre

CESKY KRUMLOV CHATEAU AND CASTLE is the second largest in the Czech Republic after Prague Castle. The Castle with its architectural standard, cultural tradition and expanse ranks among the most important historic sights in the central European region. Building development from the 14th to 19th centuries is well-preserved in the original groundplan layout, material structure, interior installation and architectural detail.

BAROQUE THEATRE, one of the oldest preserved chateau theatres in Central Europe. Alongside the theatre building itself, visitors can view hundreds of decorations, costumes, and props, as well as an orchestra pit, theatre machinery and an extensive collection of original scripts. The theatre serves only as a working theatre museum today.

Journey back to Prague via Holašovice, the most charming village in the whole of the Czech Republic. with its beautiful Baroque farms. Holasovice is on the UNESCO World Cultural and Natural Heritage List

Visit some of the original production and cellar spaces, see the unique film and taste some specialties from the museum bar. Finally visit the museum shop.

Afternoon continues by walking in the spa center and tasting a hot springs, visit of underground of main spring called "Vřídlo". - 13:30 visit of national wine centre, visit of vineayrds

- 19:30 transfer to Brno, overnight

8:00 departure from Prague direction South Moravia, visit of Chateau Lednice & Greenhouse

LEDNICE-VALTICE COMPLEX, which has been included in the UNESCO list, is known as the Garden of Europe. The elegant area around the spectacular Lednice and Valtice chateaux. An absolutely unique park has been created here over the centuries, full of rare tree species, romantic little buildings, fishponds and beautiful little corners.

Lunch in Lednice

NATIONAL WINE CENTRE is situated in the historical premises of the Valtice Chateau. Wine Salon of the Czech Republic is the highest wine competition in the Czech Republic. Wines applying for the Wine Salon first of all need to go through the system of nominating exhibitions, only on this basis the wine-maker can apply for assessment in the Wine Salon. Only wines made from grapes grown in the Czech Republic can apply. Then the wine samples go through the assessment in the committee of wine-tasters, which awards the best 100 wines the right to mark their label with the words "Wine Salon of the Czech Republic".

Visit of Vineyard in the South Moravia, get to know the methods of production of wine, digest the tasting programme and enjoy the dinner in the Wine cellar with cimbalom folklore music.

After dinner drive to Brno - accommodation.

# BRNO & SOUTH MORAVIA

In the morning guided tour of Villa Tugendhat and the city centre of Brno (Špilberk Castle, Labyrinth underneath Zelný Trh etc.)

Lunch in Brno.

BRNO - A dominant feature of Brno is the Gothic Cathedral of St. Peter and Paul on Petrov Hill, which is linked to several legends and which saved the city from the Swedish army during the Thirty Years War. Špilberk fortress rises up to the sky opposite the cathedral, formerly a highly feared prison, which is now used as a museum and gallery.

The greatest architectural boast of the city is however Villa Tugendhat which is included in the prestigious UNESCO list. The building itself and its interiors still fascinate visitors in the 21st century.

# OSTRAVA

*One of the as-yet-undiscovered treasures in North Moravia with fascinating technical monuments, also the famous Stodolní, symbol of fun and a street which never sleeps. The dominant feature of Ostrava is the unique Lower Area of Vítkovice, which was included on the European cultural heritage list.*

## PROGRAM:

### DAY 1

- 8.45 departure by train from Prague to Ostrava
- 12.38 arrival to Ostrava, check-in at the hotel
- 13:30 lunch
- 15:00 program in Ostrava – Lower area of Vítkovice, Bolt tower, tower of the New Town Hall
- 19:00 evening cultural program with dinner
- 22:00 back to the hotel, overnight

At 8.45 transfer by bus to Main Railway Station and departure by train at 9.37 to Ostrava. At 12.38 arrival to Ostrava and transfer to the hotel, check-in at the hotel. Tour of the Lower District of Vitkovice

The LOWER AREA OF VÍTKOVICE is a unique industrial complex dating back to the first half of the 19th century, which provides a superb insight into the tradition of iron production in this area. Through gradual reconstruction, a unique world of technology was created here, which allows you to get to know the steel city really well just like in the Jules Verne novel. The Vítkovice Iron Works used to belong to the Rothschild family of bankers. Just like Baťa architecture is typical in Zlín, we can admire the typical Rothschild houses in Vítkovice which were used to house the employees of their business.

Continue to the city centre and evening view of Ostrava from Bolt tower, the tower of the New Town Hall, which rises up to a height of 73 metres over the city.

Evening culminating with the cultural program.

- 13:00 lunch
- 15:21 departure from Ostrava to Prague

After breakfast tour of the city center with a guide.

Time for coffee in the Elektra Café, the café with unique history and interior.

Continue to „Michal“ Coal Mine and spend an hour in the miner's skin

MICHAL COAL MINE - upon completion of mining in this deep coal mine, the complex of surface buildings from 1912 to 1915 was preserved. The tour includes expositions in an office building, a mining building, a machine room with original electrical machines and other attractions.

Transfer to the railway station and depart by train at 15.21 to Prague. Arrival to Prague at 18.22 to the Prague's Main Railway Station.
