





11 November - Views from above: Seaplane Tour

Enjoy sweeping views of Dubai's skyscrapers, beaches and architectural marvels on a thrilling 45-minute seaplane flight. 12 November - A day of tradition: Sheikh Mohammed Centre for Cultural Understanding

Enveloped by the ambience of a traditional home – a typical wind tower house in one of the oldest Emirati neighbourhoods in Bur Dubai – the enlightening experience will leave you with an understanding

of Emirati culture and heritage. Enjoy a walk through the Al Bastakiya neighborhood of the Al Fahidi Historic District and a visit to the Diwan Mosque. Return to SMCCU for a traditional meal while chatting with an Emirati host about the UAE's culture, customs and religion.

13 November - A Mesmerising Falcon Experience

Gain an in-depth understanding of the traditional and noble art of falconry with an opportunity for a hands-on close encounter with hunting falcons in the desert. Enjoy a leisurely dune drive from the Dubai Desert Conservation Reserve to the

falcon campsite, but make sure to look for the majestic Arabian oryx en-route. Once there, you will learn about a selection of falcon species and the ancient art of falconry while watching experts fly the powerful and majestic bird.

14 November - Soak in the sights: Cruise on the Arabian Gulf

Relax and enjoy a leisurely sail on a crewed yacht with spectacular sightseeing along the Dubai coastline, with close views of The Palm Jumeirah and Burj Al Arab. Feel a gentle offshore breeze as you slide along the waves, and admire the crystal blue sea and sunshine while enjoying the sights of the most breathtaking skyline in the Gulf.

Geography

Situated on the shores of the Arabian Gulf and part of the United Arab Emirates (UAE), Dubai sits at the crossroads between East and West, blending Arabic culture and traditions with modernity to provide a warm welcome for people of all backgrounds.

The city's roots go back to 1833, when an influential group of around 800 members of the Bani Yas tribe - one of the most significant tribes of Southern Arabia - led by members of the Al Maktoum family, settled in Dubai near the mouth of the Dubai Creek.

In 1971, the UAE was founded by uniting the seven emirates into a federation. Today, the country's population is around 9.5 million, with just over 3 million living in Dubai. As a cosmopolitan city in which 85% are expatriates, the population constitutes a melting pot of over 200 nationalities from all corners of the world.

Getting There

Dubai's ideal location means that one-third of the world's population is within a four-hour flight and two-thirds are within an eight-hour flight. Dubai International Airport, the world's busiest hub for international passenger traffic, services 260 destinations across 6 continents through more than 140 scheduled airlines. The city's strong connectivity with the rest of the world is spearheaded by Emirates Airline, which operates a modern fleet between Dubai and more than 150 destinations. Meanwhile, the city's other homegrown airline, flydubai, has rapidly expanded and the low-cost carrier now services more than 90 destinations.

Visa and Passport Regulations

All passengers travelling to the United Arab Emirates require passports that must be valid for at least six months from date of entry to into the UAE.

Nationals of the following countries (including all EU member-states) who hold regular passports are eligible to obtain a 30-day UAE visa upon arrival: Arab Gulf Co-operation Council (GCC) States, Australia, Andorra, Austria, Brunei, Belgium, Bulgaria, Canada, People's Republic of China, Croatia, Czech Republic, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong SAR, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Russia, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom, United States of America and Vatican City.

Travellers from countries not listed above will need to arrange a visa in advance of travel. All visa applications are subject to approval by immigration authorities. For further information, please visit the website of the UAE Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation (www.mofa.gov.ae).

Transfers

Airport transfers, as well as transport to and from all social evening events, will be provided from official hotels, which will have hospitality desks for any enquiries. If you are staying in a different hotel, you can go to one of the official hotels to catch a transfer to the social events.

Since all official hotels are located within walking distance of Dubai World Trade Centre, transfers will not be provided between hotels and the Congress venue.
