Heritage Village Abu Dhabi

Visit the Heritage village to experience the traditional aspects of the desert way of life, and immerse yourself in the time capsule that brings to life a souk, a mosque and an encampment from premodernized Abu Dhabi. You can shop, explore artifacts and watch artisans making pottery, blowing glass and weaving fabric on a loom.

Run by the Emirates Heritage Club, this reconstruction of a traditional oasis village provides an interesting glimpse into the emirate's past and features public workshops where craftsmen demonstrate traditional skills such as metal work, pottery, weaving and spinning. The craftsmen share their skills with visitors, and occasionally offer them a chance to try them out. The little spice shop within the village offers a range of dried herbs, handmade soaps and plenty of souvenirs to collect.





An architectural marvel

This architectural work of art is one the world's largest mosques, with a capacity for an astonishing 41,000 worshippers. It features 82 domes, over a 1,000 columns, 24 carat gold gilded chandeliers and the world's largest hand knotted carpet. The main prayer hall is dominated by of the world's largest chandeliers -10 metres in diameter, 15 metres in height and weighing twelve tonnes. The mosque's first ceremony was the funeral of its namesake, Sheikh Zayed, who is buried at the site. Reflective pools surround the mosque, amplifying its beauty. The striking white and gold colours shining in the sun are transformed at night by a unique lightning system which reflects the phases of the moon.

Historical Icons

The tour begins with a drive along Dubai's Beach Road where guests can catch a glimpse of the magnificent Jumeirah Mosque and the glamorous beachside royal palaces, before heading to the city's historical heartland, Al Fahidi Neighbourhood. It ranks as Dubai's oldest district and is home to many buildings and experiences that tell the story of this captivating city.

Highlights include:

- The old wind tower and red sand houses built by wealthy merchants during the early 20th Century.
- Artistic walls of the neighbourhood
- An Abra (water taxi) ride across Dubai Creek.

Textile Souk

On the Bur Dubai side of the Creek you'll discover the colourful Textile Souk. A favourite haunt of the city's in-demand tailors and emerging fashion designers, the Souk's vast array of shops are crowded with rolls of fabric, including fine silks, airy cottons, exotic palm frond weaves, and dazzling sari fabrics. Choose from your favourite materials and pop into one of the surrounding tailors to be measured for a dress, abaya (traditional kandoura womenswear), (traditional menswear) or suit made to your design. Most can turn around orders in mere days.

Dubai Creek

The creek remains the lifeblood of Dubai - a bustling waterway that merges the past and present. On one side modern skyscrapers tell the story of 'New Dubai' while on the other, souks (marketplaces) and dhows (wooden sailing boats) laden with cargo, keep tradition alive.

Highlights include:

- A stroll along the vibrant creek.
- The gold souk be dazzled by endless shop windows filled with gold, diamonds and gemstones and barter for fine jewelry at knock-down prices.
- Take in the heady fragrances of the aromatic spice souk.

Top tip

Bargaining is expected and most shops offer discounts. Merchants love bartering banter – it's all part of Dubai's souk experience.
