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### **Hospital data:**


- Single person injuries

#2 Vehicle shunts




## Police data - focus on vehicle crashes






## Hospital data makes the real issue clear






## Categories of injuries 2015 (hospital data)

# Annual cost of single pedestrian injuries in Stockholm:

- SEK 500 million (CA\$ 75 million)
