GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTERS

For proper display at the venue, your poster size should stay within the following **maximum dimensions (Portrait)**:

Width: 97 cm
Height: 147 cm

1. When preparing your poster, use adequate letter type and size to ensure good readability. Well-designed figures, graphs and tables will enhance the attractiveness of your poster.
2. Poster boards in the poster area will be numbered by means of the abstract code (beginning with the letter P) appearing in the scheduling confirmation sent to you. You will also find your abstract code in the final program on the ECP 2017 website mid-April 2017. We suggest you mention the abstract code on your poster for the convenience of poster viewers.
3. The title on your poster should be identical to the title of the corresponding abstract.
4. Posters should show the names and affiliations of all contributing authors appearing on the abstract.
5. The identity of experimental agents or technologies should be disclosed on the poster.
6. Use generic drug names or drug code numbers. Trademarks should be avoided, but may be mentioned once between brackets the first time a product/ service/technology is mentioned in the text. Trademarks should not be used in the title.
7. Financial support received for the work described in the poster should be acknowledged in the poster.
8. **Posters should be mounted on the day your poster is scheduled 20 minutes before the session starts.** Mounting materials will be available in the poster area.
9. The presenting author should be in the vicinity of his/her poster during the poster viewing sessions on the assigned day. Please, check the final program for the poster viewing schedule.
10. You are advised to bring hard copies of your poster as handouts.
11. **Your poster should be removed from the poster board 10 minutes after your poster session.** Posters not removed by the presenters will be removed by the organizers and will be destroyed.
12. The first and presenting author of a poster, scheduled for presentation at ECP 2017, which without notice is not displayed during poster viewing hours, will be barred from having abstracts accepted for the next ECP Congress.
