


Session Types



Show Your Passion and Enthusiasm



Avoid Sales Pitch and Promotion

PREPARING YOUR PRESENTATION (PART 2)

DRAFT Presentations DUE: Friday, 13 September

- Download official PMO Symposium PowerPoint Presentation Template from Speaker Toolkit
- Be sure to reference your advertised session description and learning objectives.
- Keep in mind the target audience and audience demographics.
- Copyright and Citing References
- Save file name as LastName_FirstName-presentation.ppt (ex. Smith_John-presentation_DRAFT.ppt)



FINAL Presentations DUE: Friday, 11 October

 Once Reviewer Feedback has been received, PMO Presenters should plan on submitting final presentations by Friday, 11 October
