The termination date	The termination date the landlord sets out in this notice must be at least <b>10 days</b> after the landlord gives you this notice.					
What if you disagree with the notice?	You do not have to move out if you disagree with what the landlord has put in this notice. However, the landlord can apply to the Board for an order to evict you. The Board will schedule a hearing where you can explain why you disagree.					
What if you move out?	If you move out of the rental unit by the termination date, your tenancy ends on that date. However, if your landlord gave you this notice because you damaged the rental unit or the residential complex, you may still owe the landlord money for the damage.					
What if the landlord applies to the Board?	If the landlord applies to the Board to evict you, the Board will schedule a hearing and send you a copy of the application and the <i>Notice of Hearing</i> . The <i>Notice of Hearing</i> sets out the date, time and location of the hearing. At the hearing, the landlord will have to prove the claims they made in this <i>Notice to End your Tenancy</i> and in the application and you can respond to the claims your landlord makes.
