

## 2019 ONPHA Gala Content Rules

### Eligibility

This Contest is open to those who purchase a 2019 ONPHA Gala ticket, whether online or onsite the evening of the ONPHA Gala before it begins at 7 p.m. if tickets are still available for purchase.

The Contest is only open to legal residents of Canada, and is void where prohibited by law. Employees of the Ontario Non-Profit Housing Association, Employees of Sponsor, and other companies associated with the promotion of the Contest, its affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising and promotion agencies, and suppliers, and immediate family members (spouse, parents, siblings, and children) and/or those living in the same household of Employees are not eligible to participate in the Contest. ### Contest Period - start and end date
