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Goals of the Traineeship Program

- Address barriers for PWLE
- Increase representation of PWLE in Social Service agencies
- · Prove it can be done
- Encourage other organizations to take on similar programming

Implementation

- Format
 - Recruitment, selection, training month, placement, on-going employment supports
- Selection
 - Job posting
 - Information sessions
 - Application
 - Interviews

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Placements

- Different areas of the organization
- 11 month placements
- Goal is to learn the skills of full time staff in these areas





Employment Supports

- Connected with staff from Fred Victor's Employment and Training Services
- Supervisors are encouraged to pass on job postings
