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VISION

London's Housing Vision: "...where all members of the community have access to housing that is safe, secure, and suitable to their needs and ability to pay."



APPROACH

1. Lean start-up: Approach based on minimum sustainable viability

- 2. Internal Collaborative Group
- 3. Initial Tools to be Considered for the HDC
- 4. Establish Priorities
- 5. Focus of Initial 4 Years then through multi-year business plans



MANDATES

Housing Development Corporation

Core Mandate

• The HDC stimulates the development and sustainability of affordable housing throughout London and Middlesex.

Supporting Mandates

- The HDC supports the local need for revitalized and strengthened neighbourhoods, and diverse and inclusive communities.
- The HDC collaborates with all sectors to create and sustain affordable housing and stimulate economic growth.



GOVERNANCE

- •Separate entity with the City as Sole Shareholder
- •Council Appointed Board of Directors with industry expertise
- •Focus on development HDC will not operate housing

•Capital funding approved by Council through annual budget process







ADMINISTRATION

•Current relationship to the City of London

- Assumption of current housing development activities
- Shared services with the City
- Social Housing Service Manager role







INDEPENDENT ENTITY

- Catalyst to enable new affordable housing
- Central point of contact at City for new affordable housing projects
- Ability to focus on gaps/niche in current housing market
- Expedited and streamlined processes to enable leveraging of city land and assets for affordable housing
- Standardization of tools and policies
- Industry & market knowledge through independent and volunteer Board





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WHAT WE'VE LEARNED

- Other cities are using HDC or alternative delivery models
- Many in Ontario exploring and interested in London model
- Relies on ongoing support and engagement of all sectors (not-forprofit & private) and orders of government, including municipal departments.





MORE LEARNING

- Will advance and support other local plans including Official Plan
- Some new tools will require new partnerships and players
