



How do I qualify?

First, if you can answer **“yes”** to all these questions, your home may qualify.

- 1 Is your home heated by natural gas?
- 2 Are you a customer of Enbridge Gas Distribution?
- 3 Do you pay your own natural gas bill?

You qualify if you participate in one of the following government assistance programs:

- Ontario Works
- Guaranteed Income Supplement
- National Child Benefit Supplement
- Allowance for Seniors
- Allowance for Survivors
- Ontario Disability Support Program
- Electric Utility HAP Program
- Healthy Smiles Ontario Child Dental Program

NOTE: The **FREE** Home Weatherization Program will not affect your income from government assistance programs.

How can I save money and energy?

As your home's energy efficiency goes up, your costs can do down. Enbridge Gas Distribution wants to help customers do just that. How? through our Home Weatherization Program.

Enbridge will pay for the cost of home improvements such as insulation and draft proofing.

The program is:

- For people in financial need.
- Whether you own or rent a detached home, semi-detached home, row house or mobile home.

Why should I participate?

You have many great reasons to join the **FREE** Home Weatherization Program:

- Save money. The program can cut your energy demand by 30%. That means lower bills.
- Be more comfortable. An energy-efficient home has fewer drafts, and lets you control the temperature.
- Get healthier. Fewer drafts mean a more comfortable home for you and your family.
- Increase your home's value. Potential buyers and tenants like energy-efficient homes.
- Protect the environment. The less energy you use, the cleaner the air.

You also qualify if your household income (before tax income of all household members 18 years or older) is no more than the amounts on the following chart.

Household Size	Maximum Gross Annual Income
One Occupant	\$31,452
Two Occupants	\$39,155
Three Occupants	\$48,137
Four Occupants	\$58,444
Five Occupants	\$66,288
Six Occupants	\$74,760
Seven or More Occupants	\$83,236

How do I apply?

- 1 Call your Enbridge Program Delivery Agent in your area (the phone numbers are listed on the back of this brochure). They may be able to pre-qualify your home over the phone. You will need to provide a signed application and proof of income eligibility along with:
 - The account number on your gas bill
 - A copy of your last income tax assessment or benefit statement. (We don't need your Social Insurance Number; so, you can black it out.)
- 2 Mail or fax the application to the Enbridge Program Delivery Agent in your area or Enbridge Gas Distribution by December 31, 2013. The addresses are on the back of this brochure.

What happens next?

- 1 Your application is reviewed.
- 2 If you are eligible for the program, your Enbridge Program Delivery Agent in your area will schedule a first visit to your home.
- 3 The Enbridge Program Delivery Agent will conduct a pre-energy audit of your home to find out what home improvements are required to make it more energy efficient and comfortable.
- 4 If your home qualifies, the Enbridge Program Delivery Agent will book an appointment to send a crew of professional contractors to install insulation and draft-proofing measures that save you energy.
- 5 After the work is completed, the Enbridge Program Delivery Agent will come back in a few weeks to perform a post-energy audit and measure how your energy efficiency has improved. The greatest efficiency savings are likely in homes older than 30 years.
