Instructions to Format Presentation Files

PowerPoint Set Up

The screen in your presentation room will be **16:9 aspect ratio**. Presentations formatted in 14:8 aspect ratio will still display correctly, however there will be black frames on either side of the screen.

Instructions to make a Widescreen HD format file:

- 1. Open your existing PowerPoint or create a new file
- 2. Convert the presentation into widescreen (16:9 ratio)
 - a. PowerPoint 2013
 - i. Select 'Design' tab
 - ii. Slide Size, Widescreen (16:9) this is the default

b. PowerPoint 2007, 2010

- i. Select 'Design Tab'
- ii. Select 'Page Setup'
- iii. If you're making a new blank presentation, select 'slides size for: On screen 16:9
- iv. If you're converting an existing presentation, enter width = 13.33" and height = 7.5"
- c. PowerPoint 2003
 - i. Select File menu, 'Page Setup'
 - ii. Select 'slides sized for: Custom'
 - iii. If you're making a new blank presentation, enter 10" width and 5.63" height
 - iv. If you're converting an existing presentation, enter width = 13.33" and height = 7.5"
- 3. Slide orientation should be 'Landscape'

- Save your file in a PPTX format for both Macintosh and PC
- Be sure to test your presentation on a PC running Windows 7
