What is PaaS, anyway?

- "Platform as a service" is a collection of app dev and deployment tools and technologies focused on the development, deployment, and management of applications/services delivered via the cloud. PaaS typically have at least these five elements:
- Support for user interaction development and deployment
- Support for one or more application/service development patterns
- Support for orchestration of business processes and managed deployment of developed artifacts
- Service interface(s) for interoperability with external services
- Management services that control access to the PaaS and how the PaaS leverages system infrastructure
