






15% of organizations' total IT budget is allocated to IT security


Q. How tightly integrated are IT security strategy and IT strategy at your organization today? AND

Cybersecurity Tops the List for Increased Technology Spending




Q. Will your spending for each of the following categories increase, decrease or remain the same in the next 12 months compared to the past 12 months?


Security Tops the List of Most Recent Technology Projects



Q. Please select the three enterprise IT products or service categories you were most recently involved in purchasing in the past 24 months.




Data Security and Protection Are Digital Business Priorities

The CIO's Role is Expanding



Organizations Recognize the Need to Establish a Progressive IT Workplace Culture

- A progressive workplace culture:
 - cultivates and sustains a comprehensive talent transformation strategy
 - is mission driven and embraces excellence, collaboration, learning and continuous improvement as core competencies
- CIO/CTO/IT leadership is involved along with operations, human resources and marketing/branding
- This builds the next generation of IT talent with emerging technical skills and dynamic leadership capabilities



What Are the Steps to Establishing a Progressive IT Culture?

- Determine the future needs of the IT organization
- Establish a clear vision and mission statement for the future IT organization
- Change the talent conversation across the organization
- Embrace "technical leadership" as a core competency
- Create a "speak up culture" for all IT talent
