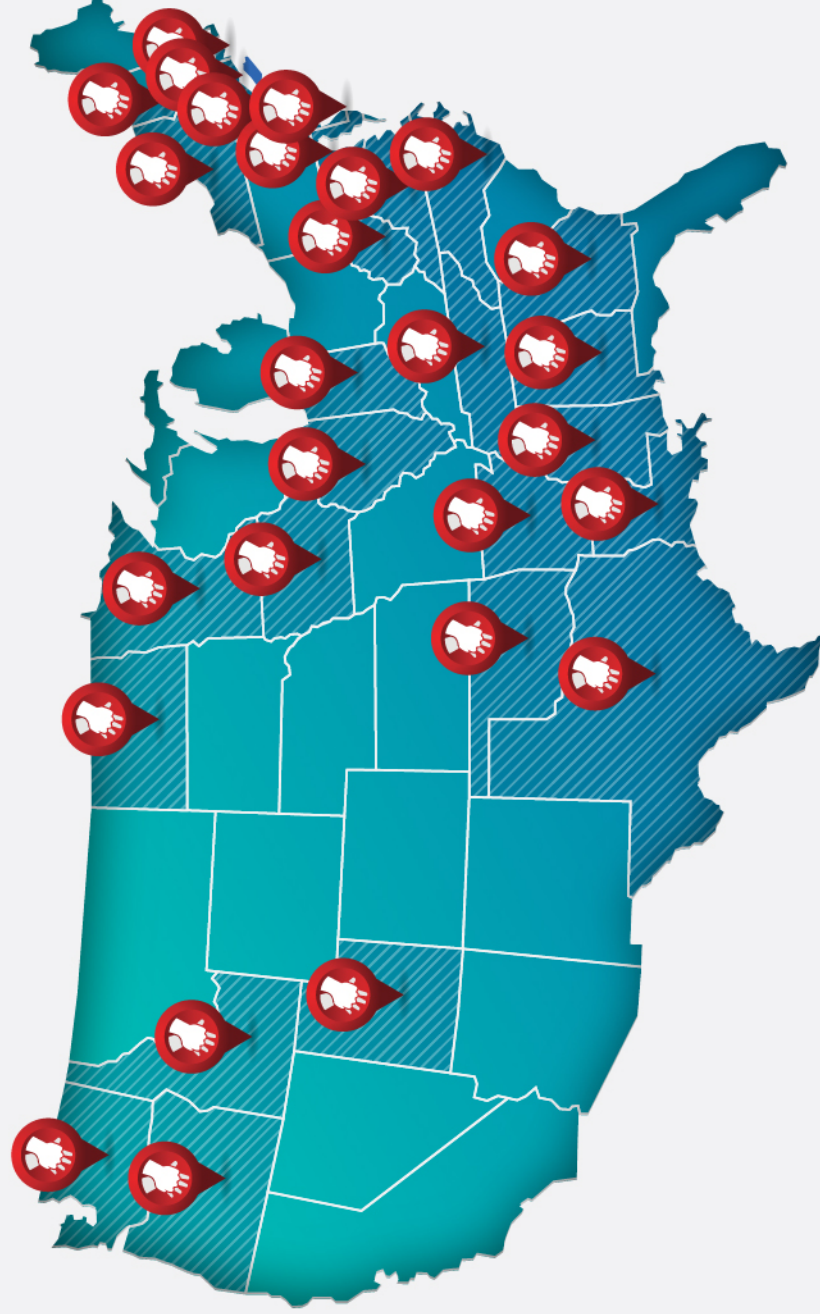


LIFESAVERS IN SCHOOL
