CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

"Scalpels, Scopes & Sheaths" Kaiser Permanente Combined General & Vascular Surgery/GI/IR National Symposium

Thursday, June 20 – Saturday, June 22, 2019 (Seattle, Washington)

Eligibility:

Any resident enrolled in a Kaiser Permanente residency or rotating through a Kaiser Permanente facility is eligible to enter the competition. Each resident can submit up to TWO clinically based abstracts for consideration. Abstracts that have been presented at a previous scientific meeting are acceptable. Each abstract *must be* investigative work done predominantly at a Kaiser Permanente facility in association with a Kaiser Permanente faculty physician. Please no case reports in eligibility

In addition, presenters will be asked to participate in case presentations during the conference.

Format of presentation:

A limited number of abstracts will be chosen for oral presentation in the **Resident Session on Friday June 21rd, 2019, from 8-10 AM.** Each resident will be allocated fifteen minutes for formal presentation, followed by a ten-minute period for questions and answers. Audience participation and/or accompanied clinical video presentations are appreciated in the final presentation.

Prize and Travel Assistance:

Resident presenters should obtain a travel grant from their respective residency programs to aid in the cost of travel. The National Surgery Symposium will provide financial assistance for covering transportation expenses (coach airfare or mileage reimbursement) and <u>up to two nights</u> hotel accommodations. The winner of the resident presentation will receive an award of \$500.

<u>Deadline for submission – Friday February 22, 2019</u>:

The selection of abstracts by the Program Committee, and the notification of applicants will happen by March 15th, 2019.
