#### **Our People**



The Techtel Group has regional offices in Sydney and Singapore with branches in Auckland and Melbourne. Staff allocations are generally split 40% for sales, 40% for support and 20% for administration services. We have full time product/application specialists, trainers, IT engineers, broadcast engineers and platform specialists, also drawing on contract labour when required. The company's head office of 1000sqm is in Artarmon NSW, a suburb 7km from the central business district of Sydney and close to all major broadcast facilities, technology hubs and post production houses. Our Melbourne office is located in the inner-city Melbourne suburb of Kew, VIC.

### Our Sales & Marketing

Techtel staff continually strive to establish, maintain and further our one-on-one relationships with each of our customers for the purpose of understanding their needs, and subsequently providing the very best solution to suit these needs. Exhibiting and attending tradeshows is a mandatory requirement if we are to serve both our customers and our suppliers to the best of our ability.
