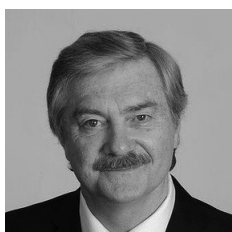
**Dr Richard Evans,

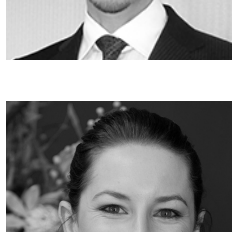
**Dr Yohei Tanaka,

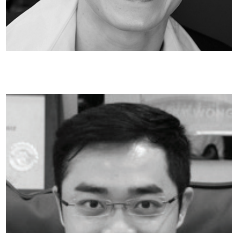
**Carly Whytcross,
