and thank you for this opportunity to send you information on sponsorship opportunities for the Public Health Association national conference in September 2012. This year the conference will be held in Wellington, and we expect approximately 350 delegates from throughout New Zealand to participate.

The theme of the conference is "Equity from the Start, Valuing our Children": The conference will focus on New Zealand's children and the social determinants of their well-being, as well as our responsibility to provide for every child in New Zealand an equal opportunity, regardless of their parents' income, education or ethnic status.

Given this theme, the conference planning committee is eager to engage the broader network of people involved in New Zealand children's wellbeing, including but not exclusive to public health professionals. We are also exploring ways to engage children themselves at the conference, to enable us all to see these members of our community not just as benefactors and consumers, but as active shapers of our present and future.

Last year the Public Health Association set a precedent at its national conference in Christchurch by working towards CarbonZeroTM certification through the carboNZeroTM programme. This year the Wellington PHA will carry on with this commitment to measure, manage, and mitigate emissions related to all aspects of the conference.

With both this commitment to sustainability and our efforts to engage children and youth within its programme, this conference promises to be an innovative and exciting experience for its attendants, binding them to the values of public health regardless of their professional background.

Sponsorship Benefits

Venue

The conference will be held in the Pipitea Campus of Victoria University, close to the waterfront in the heart of Wellington's CBD and across from parliament buildings. The campus is also close to Wellington's central train station and bus depot, making transport to and from the conference highly accessible.



Profile of Delegates

Delegates range from primary and secondary care professionals in a variety of fields within public health, to policy makers and developers, researchers, and members of local and national government. All share a common interest in the public health of New Zealand, but while some are there to gain professional development, others are there because of the unique forum for discussion the PHA conference is renowned for.

Each year, the regional board charged with hosting the conference looks to engage a greater community of delegates, based upon a theme. This year, with the theme Equity from the start – valuing our Children, the Wellington board hopes to draw interest from the education sector and its wider network of agencies with a workforce involved with children's welfare and development.

Your involvement

The conference will take place over three days, though the first day will be devoted to gateway events that have a specific focus inside the broader theme of children's wellbeing/equity and/or public health. The format for gateway events is open to interpretation so that hosting groups may have the opportunity to workshop, train, or take delegates on a tour. Exhibitor displays

In order to provide sponsors with optimum exposure to delegates, the exhibition area will be located in the main hub of the conference venue, where lunch, morning and afternoon tea breaks will be held.

Pounamu and Gold Sponsors will be provided one exhibition stand (skirted trestle table) and allocated space (3.6m wide x 1.2m deep) at the discretion of the conference organisers. Silver and Paua Sponsors will be provided one exhibition stand (skirted trestle table) and allocated space (2.4m wide x 1.2m deep) at the discretion of the conference organisers. Higher visibility/closer proximity to delegates will be given to higher status sponsors.

Pounamu and Gold sponsors will be provided spot lighting and will have the option of power supply to their stands.

Sponsors will be given priority for setting up exhibitor displays at the conference. If space permits, display sites will be available to other agencies.
