## About the Event

The European Organisation of Prison and Correctional Services (EuroPris) in cooperation with the International Corrections and Prisons Association (ICPA) and the Confederation of European Probation (CEP) will organise in 15-17 May 2017 the second Global Corrections Digital Technology Conference, 'Technology in Corrections: Challenges for the Future' and will be hosted by the Czech Prison and Probation Services.

Prison administrations and probation services are currently facing a number of challenges. On one hand the emphasis is on professionalization, efficiency with more individualized and client-centric approaches towards the offender, and a strong focus on preparing re-entry into society. On the other hand, special attention has to be given to the importance of guaranteeing public security and finding the right balance and responses to new evolutions in society such as radicalization. Doing all this within the restraints of a difficult economic and budgetary context constitutes a difficult challenge. As in all sectors, we believe that technology can help us with these challenges. Even more, we believe that innovation is a necessity if we want to find sustainable solutions to our problems.

## Aims

The aim of this conference is to challenge you, the technological companies and experts, to help us in finding solutions and to make proposals on how you think technology can help us in our specific setting of corrections both inside and outside the prison walls.

The purpose of this event is to:

- Challenge the private sector to develop innovative digital solutions for use in corrections to address issues facing prisons and probation today;

## About the City

Situated in the northwest of the country on the Vltava River, Prague is the capital and the largest city of the Czech Republic. ## The Venue

## Transport to the Venue

### From the Václav Havel International Airport

Take bus no. 119 from the airport to its final stop "Nádraží Vevešlavín" then take metro line A to "Dejvická" station (2 stops). There change to bus no. 143 and continue to "Malovanka" stop (4 stops). The hotel is situated just 250m from the bus stop.

### By Taxi

You can find taxis in front of the arrival halls of both terminals. Taxi is more expensive than public transport and it is only slightly faster. It is reasonable to use taxis for night arrivals/departures, when bus line 119 does not operate (after 23:45).
