



We were able to provide over \$13 MILLION in critical support of the NSW community, including:

in Transition Assistance to support the 250 SEALs annually who transition from military service to civilian life

To address the mounting cumulative physical and mental challenges our warriors and their families face, we hosted our Second Annual Whole Warrior Health Collective Impact Forum, an event designed to improve the provision of health services to military personnel and their families in the fields of: Neuroscience, Neuroplasticity and Neural Integration, Optimizing Sleep to Perform, Recover and Thrive, Chronic Pain and the Management of Complex and Chronic Pain, and How to Turn Stress into an Advantage. Over 700 participants and care providers were educated in the newest treatment techniques, and we'll see this impact in the quality of medical care a service member or veteran receives.

Because of your support, the Foundation was able to expand its Signature Programs to NSW Commands in remote locations in addition to major areas. In 2017 Germany and Stennis experienced their first 'Princess and her Frog' event and 'Breakfast with Santa' was also expanded. These events provide NSW Families the ability to reconnect in a secure environment as well as create memories to keep with them when they are separated by deployment for great lengths of time.
