Responsible City Tour + visit to a social organizations in La Boca with snack included

In the morning pick up at the hotel to start our Responsible City Tour of Buenos Aires by private van / bus and accompany by an English speaking guide. We visit the famous Recoleta Cemetery, Palermo with its green areas, parks and squares that make it one of the most popular districts of the city. Then we move to the historical quarter to see the Plaza de Mayo and its surrounding buildings (the Cabildo, the Cathedral, the Government House). Later we pass through the old neighborhood of San Telmo to later reach La Boca, one of the tourist areas of Buenos Aires and the poorest neighborhood at the same time. We start touring the iconic Caminito street, with artists selling paintings and then, along with our expert guide we insert ourselves into the less touristic parts of the neighborhood by visiting a local cooperative founded by locals. They produce “alfajores” and give employment in this small factory to people living in La Boca. We enjoy a snack (alfajores, coffee, mate, tea) while chatting with the founder and members of the cooperative. Thus, the group gain a deeper insight of the current socio-economic situation of the district, contributing to this social project. After it, return to the hotel by private van.



Why this tour is responsible?

The visits support the sustainable development of organizations working for the betterment of the quality of life of the inhabitants of Buenos Aires. In all our tours is donated money to all organizations visited. The visits also support neighborhood clubs and cultural centers whose existence depends on the membership fee of the members.
