

Abstract Submission Guidelines

*(The term organiser means INDEX Conferences & Exhibitions Organisation Est.)

- Abstract should not exceed 100 words. The abstract must be in English.
- Abstracts should be submitted through online submission at www.dubaiderma.com
- Abstracts that are handwritten, sent by email or fax will ***not be accepted***.
- Abstract content must meet the standard of an academic / scientific presentation.
- In cases of research or clinical study, the abstract must be based on the original research or original clinical case studies, or their modifications.
- The **Dubai Derma Scientific Organising Committee** will evaluate the content of each abstract and make the final selection of the abstracts for presentation.
- The presentation must cover the same material as the abstract.
- If the abstract has been selected for presentation, the speaker automatically gives permission for publishing the abstract in the Dubai Derma Conference Program or to any post-conference announcement.

No abstracts will be considered after **30th November 2018**.

- For any withdrawals, the speaker should notify the *organiser in writing as soon as possible or minimum of **2 months** prior to the event.
- Any particular equipment and materials which is necessarily to conduct the session is be declared to organiser and approved to be obtained latest by the submission of the presentation.

P.S: Please respect the deadline for presentation submission (**20th of January 2019**). Any delay in submitting the presentation will result in similar delay of the CPD accreditation and possibly in canceling the session.
