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DESCRIPTION:

The Music Care Certificate Program is a 3-level, 52 hour training that prepares care partners to use music in their regular practice with increased confidence and theoretical understanding. The program is suitable for all care partners and other community stakeholders interested in music and care. MCCP is intended to be person and context-centered and to improve quality of care, thus contributing to overall culture change in healthcare. Upon completion of each level of MCCP, participants are awarded a Certificate of Completion by the Room 217 Foundation demonstrating an understanding of music care principles and applications. This certificate may be used as proof of additional training, continuing education or professional development.
