### PROJECT OVERVIEW

Altinn II is the most integrated platform for eGovernment collaboration on a SOA-architecture in the world. It's service engine enables private and public entities to integrate their service across and to their legacy system with an ROI that is 80% better than any other solution we know of.

### SOCIETAL BENEFITS

The platform is free to use for any private or government entity in Norway, as well as, there is an agreement with the World Bank to enable this to speed up the development in challenged economies.

### PROJECT BENEFIT EXAMPLE

The benefit realization report by the finance department in Norway estimates the benefit in Norway to be over 1.5 billion USD and an ROI of 6 months, 31% on governments, 38% on private businesses and 31% on citizens.
