29 October 2019

- Transfer from the airport to the hotel with English speaking driver
- Overnight at Aria Hotel Budapest

30 October 2019

- Breakfast at the hotel
- 8 hours Budapest city tour with private car/minibus and English speaking guide including guided tour in Parliament and Opera House

The tour starts from the hotel along the Andrássy Avenue to Heroes' Square. Walk around the City Park and see the famous Széchenyi Thermal Bath, the Budapest Zoo and a fairy tale castle (Vajdahunyad Vára).

From here drive to the Parliament for a guided visit of the House of the Country.

Next drive over to the Buda side and stop in the Castle District to visit all the attractions of the area (Former Royal Palace, Old Town Hall, Matthias Church, Holy Trinity Column, Fishermen's Bastion)



and the hidden alley ways as well. Afterwards drive to the Gellért Hill (Citadel) to see the most spectacular view of Budapest.

Drive back to Pest and stop at Central Market Hall, then along the small boulevard and pass the Hungarian National Museum. Walk around the Jewish District to see the Great Synagogue and the Orthodox Synagogue, the ritual bath (Mikve) and a remained part of the ghetto wall (outside)

From here continue to the Opera House for a guided visit of this unique building including a short concert inside.

31 October 2019

Visit the beautiful Baroque Palace in Gödöllő! After only a 30-minute drive from Budapest arrive to the former summer residence of Queen Elisabeth (Sisi) and Francis Joseph (Habsburg Emperor & Hungarian King 1867-1916). The interior visit of the Gödöllő Palace gives a glimpse of times under the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Guests will become acquainted with the secrets of the private life, the hidden doors, rooms and lovers of the royal couple.

The tour ends at the hotel.

Half day (4 – 4,5 hours) tour to Szentendre with private car/minibus and English speaking guide

Szentendre is a small baroque city built on medieval ruins, located at the gate of the Danube Bend. The town is considered to be the Artists' Village or the Painters' Town. (It takes only 30 minutes to get there.) Due to the Mediterranean atmosphere and proximity to Budapest, it a popular place among locals and visitors as well.

First walk around the historical centre and take a look at the cobblestoned narrow streets, baroque houses and churches. After the guided tour visit



some museums (for example the famous Margit Kovács Ceramic Museum or the Confectionery Museum with marzipan figures) and you can buy some typical Hungarian souvenirs.


