World Café - Purpose

- Facilitate discussion between individuals with diverse perspectives, knowledge, and experiences
- Discuss theme questions to facilitate collaboration and new solutions – a "crosspollination of ideas"
- "conversations about questions that matter"



- Individuals will change tables and have discussions with various different people and share ideas from the earlier discussions
 - Allows for the connection of ideas

The Café Host will guide the World Café



- Numbered tables
- Café facilitator and scribe at each table
- 4 discussion rounds
 - groups will have 15-25 minutes to talk about the discussion theme topic per round.
 - Once a discussion round is over, you will move to another table.
 - Discussion themes can be found in your program



- Once a discussion round is over, you will move to another table. Tables will be numbered 1-4 and will represent the different themes:
 - Two tables numbered 1 represent Theme 1
 - Two tables numbered 2 represent Theme 2
 - Two tables numbered 3 represent Theme 3
 - Two tables numbered 4 represent Theme 4


