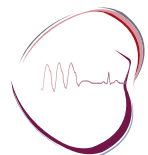

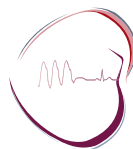

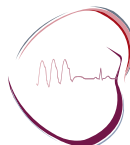

GUIDELINES

- Abstracts must be written in English.
- The title should be brief, clearly indicating the nature of the study.
- Abbreviations are allowed but must be clearly defined.
- Organise the abstract as follows:
 - Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions

TYPING INSTRUCTIONS

- The abstract must be submitted in Word. Use typeface "Times New Roman", font size 12.
- Names of authors (initial of first name and surname, underline presenting author's name only) and Institution or Hospital, City and Country must be in small letters.
- Do not repeat names of authors and institution in your text.
- Do not include degrees or titles.
- The rest of the text should contain no more than 400 words.
- Do not leave blank lines.
- Single space all typing.
- Use generic names of drugs.
- Write numbers as numerals rather than words.
- Avoid references.

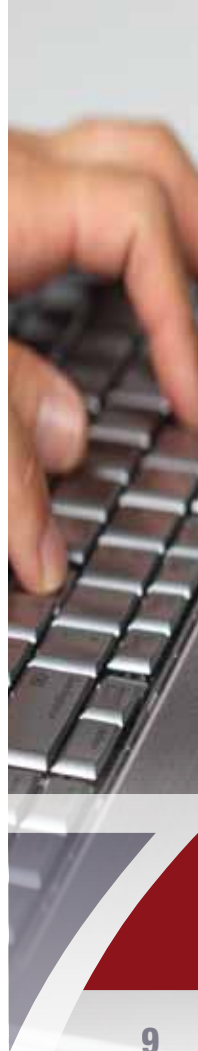
