Flavor Trail of the Island of Orleans



This gourmet tour will introduce you to the culture and the history of the region's first settlers. The Island of Orleans, classified as a historical district, is located in the middle of the St. Lawrence River. Let yourself be enchanted by its beauty, its tradition and pastoral, seasonal rhythms.

Leaving the heart of Québec City, you will stop at the **Montmorency Fall** where a cable car ride will take you to the top. The fall is a true discovery with its impressive waterfalls of 83 metre (272 feet) high and centuries of history!

Afterwards you will be lead on the beautiful and historic Island of Orleans where stops will be made to discover and taste local products.

- **A vineyard**, hectares of land that lays on the shore of the St. Lawrence River.
- **Apple Orchard**, a bio-certified farm operation located on a 15 hectares estate is composed of an ancestral home, a 4,000-tree apple orchard, ducks and geese, a cider house, a vinegar factory, and an interpretation centre with an open kitchen for processing homegrown products.

Panoramic Bicycle Ride on the South Shore

At the end of the bicycle ride, you will again take the ferryboat to go back to Old Québec. From there, you will enjoy the easy walk to "Petit Champlain" street from where you will take the Funicular (cable car which links Lower Town to Upper Town) to head back to the hotel.

Via Ferrata & Zip-line at Canyon Ste-Anne



Discover a thrilling and magical environment just 45 minutes away from Québec City. This great nature outing pleases a wide range of people. An activity designed for the thrill-seekers! Enjoy a unique excursion to the Canyon Ste-Anne providing exhilarating views and a vertical perspective you may not have thought possible. An exciting array of activities, including two Via Ferrata courses and a zip-line descent, await you.

First: Via Ferrate courses. “Via Ferrata” is Italian for “Iron Way”, a climbing route with permanent fixed cables for protection and metal ladder rungs to ease your movement over rock. This awesome experience is for guests of all abilities with no climbing experience necessary.

Second: Experience the next best thing to flying with a thrilling zip-line adventure! A zip-line consists of a pulley suspended on a cable mounted on an incline. They are designed to enable a user propelled by gravity to traverse from the top to the bottom of the inclined cable, by holding on or attaching to the freely moving pulley. Safely glide high over the Canyon (60 meters high) and 50 meters long. An unforgettable thrill!

Professional guides accompany each group and work to familiarize each participant with the equipment and safety procedures involved to make your visit a perfect gateway.

Visit of the Citadel of Québec



Come and visit the Governor General Residence combined with a guided visit of the Citadel of Québec! A great introduction to Québec's history and military life!

Governor General Residence

Located in the heart of the Citadel of Québec and overlooking the majestic St. Lawrence River, this splendid heritage structure has served as the second official home and workplace of Canada's governors general since 1872.

Citadel of Québec

Located atop Cap Diamant, the Citadel constitutes the eastern flank of Québec's fortifications. Inspired by it, romantic writers have called Québec the "Gibraltar of America". In 1820, the construction of the Citadel began; and it lasted for more than 30 years. The star-shaped plan of the Citadel is characteristic of Vauban fortifications. The continued presence of the Royal 22e Regiment at the Citadel since 1920 makes it the largest fortified group of buildings still occupied by troops in North America.

White Water Rafting



The white water rafting center, located only 45 minutes North of Québec City, is surrounded by lush mountains and clean sparkling rivers. The Jacques-Cartier River crisscrosses the breathtaking expanse of wild, mountainous uplands fractured by steep-sided valleys. Here, we have planned a rafting descent down the Jacques-Cartier River - sure to thrill beginners and experts alike.

Once everyone has been properly outfitted and the safety orientation complete, it will be time to discover "nature's roller coaster". As your river guide skillfully maneuvers your raft through class 3 and 4 rapids, you will experience the exhilaration of white water rafting on one of Québec's most exciting rivers. During the first part of the adventure, while the river is still relatively calm, your guide will provide instructions on paddling techniques. The rafting is participatory, so get ready to paddle!
