

2012 Champion of Free Clinics Award

This award was created by the Ohio Association of Free Clinics (OAFC) in 2003 to honor individuals whose dedication to and achievements in serving the healthcare needs of the working poor and uninsured provide outstanding service and leadership models.

OHIO ASSOCIATION OF FREE CLINICS

One recipient may be selected each year and recognized at the OAFC Annual Conference.

The recipient is selected based on careful review of the following (weighted) criteria:

- 1. <u>Service</u> in a free clinic(s) as a paid staff member or as a volunteer for an OAFC member free clinic. (50 points)
- 2. <u>Advocacy</u> on behalf of free clinic(s) and/or on behalf of Ohio's uninsured citizens. (35 points)
- 3. <u>Time</u> spent as a champion of Ohio's free clinics(s): stated in number of hours or years. (15 points)

Anyone may nominate a worthy candidate. There is no required minimum for the time spent in service to be considered as a champion of free clinic(s). Anyone may nominate more than one candidate, but at this time, the "Champion of Free Clinics" Award is given only to one individual each year. Previous award winners include: Dr. Brenda Prince (Tuscarawas Clinic for the Working Uninsured), Dr. Frank Petrola (Jefferson County 4th Street Health Center), Dr. John Ball (Free Clinic of Greater Cleveland), and Dr. Roger Snyder (Ashland Christian Health Center).
