DESCRIPTION:

Our objective is to create familiar and appropriate interfaces that allow residents with dementia opportunities to self-initiate (trigger), and engage and interact with Ambient Augmentation Technology (AAT). Once engaged, AAT should provide the resident individualized stimulation experiences (sight/sound-music/tactile-feel/smell/reminiscence/physical activity) that would be meaningful to the resident in order to attain a 'state of calm', thereby managing disruptive and disturbing behaviour and improving quality of life.
