

OPENING SPEAKER

PROF. BRUCE SIDNEY RUBIDGE ✓



Prof. Bruce Rubidge is Director of the DST/NRF Centre of Excellence for Palaeosciences. Following completion of his B.Sc., B.Sc. (Hons) cum laude at Stellenbosch University he was appointed to a curatorial position in the Karoo Palaeontology Department at the National Museum in Bloemfontein in 1980,

becoming Head of the Department in 1982.

He was appointed Director of the Bernard Price Institute (BPI) and Head of the Palaeontology Department at the University of the Witwatersrand. In 2013, with the amalgamation of the BPI Palaeontology and the Institute for Human Evolution (IHE) to form the Evolutionary Studies Institute (ESI) he was appointed interim director of the amalgamated institute and Director of the newly established DST/NRF Centre of Excellence for Palaeosciences. He has published more than 160 research publications in internationally accredited journals and 36 MSc and PhD students achieved their degrees under his supervision.

Being passionate to expose the palaeoheritage of South Africa to the public, Rubidge was instrumental in setting up a palaeoscience museum at Wits which forms the core of an active palaeoscience outreach programme. He was also involved in the development of the Cradle of Humankind World Heritage site, the Golden Gate Dinosaur exhibition Centre, and setting up the Kitching Fossil Exploration Centre in Nieu Bethesda as a sustainable palaeotourism business which employs local people from the town.
