EDUCATION SESSION POLICIES

Commercial-free Education

The education sessions are considered a learning experience rather than a marketing opportunity. Presenters/panelists are referred to as industry experts with knowledge they have gained from working in the automotive industry. That knowledge may be from years of experience in a dealership or intense training from an industry-related corporation. However, all presenters/panelists must insure that all sessions are commercial-free and vendor neutral.

Proposal Submission Limit

A maximum of three proposals from any individual or organization will be reviewed and considered.

Session Delivery Limits

Sessions are limited to two presenters. Panels are limited to a moderator and three panelists.

Session Follow-up and Planning Conference Calls

NIADA staff will facilitate these calls per the submission calendar and assist session planners as needed.

Honoraria, Travel Expenses and Complimentary Registration

Delivering a session at the NIADA Convention and Expo is done on a voluntary, unpaid basis.

All speakers'/panelists' individual travel, lodging and meals are at their own expense.

One full complimentary registration to the Convention and Expo is provided to all presenters, and a special registration code will be given to each speaker/panelist.

Handouts

Handouts for approved sessions must be submitted by the deadline indicated on the Submission Calendar. While your PowerPoint presentation may be your key handout, a one-page handout that captures the session's objectives that will help the attendee incorporate the learning once he/she leaves.
