## 31 October 2019

- Drive to Cracow after breakfast
- 3-hour tour of Krakow with the Royal Wawel Castle and St Mary's Church

The Old Town: The Royal Route, the Old Town Market Square, the Cloth Hall, St Mary's Church with famous 15th

century wooden Witt Stwosz altar inside and Florianska Gate, resembling an open-air art gallery with numerous paintings and watercolours displayed for sale by local artists.

The Royal Wawel Hill with the Royal Wawel Cathedral and the Royal Wawel Castle - the Gothic Royal Castle was built on the remains of the 10th century settlement and extended in Renaissance style in the 16th century. Renaissance interiors contain numerous paintings, furniture and national memorabilia.



The Gothic Royal Cathedral contains reminders of the first, Romanesque cathedral, dating back to the 11th century. Cathedral is also a necropolis of Polish Kings, Dukes and noble citizens.

#### <u>1 November 2019</u>

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Visit in Auschwitz Birkenau

The Auschwitz concentration camp is a grim reminder of Nazi terror and holocaust, "death factory" within famous crematoria. New Museum of Martyrdom - consists of brick barracks with tons of hair, shoes, glasses and other belongings of victims. This is truly a tour that you'll remember for the rest of your life.

## 2 November 2019

- Visit in Wieliczka Salt Mines

Wieliczka Salt Mine is a unique world-class attraction, included in the UNESCO "Human Heritage" List. A tour of the Mine includes chapels sculpted in salt (Blessed Kinga's chapel is the most beautiful one), spacious chambers, crystal grottoes and underground ponds. All this at average depth of 250 m below the ground level.



• Drive back to Warsaw with a visit in Częstochowa on the way

For several centuries the name of this town has always been associated with its largest and most important historic monument – the monastery and stronghold of Jasna Gora, which with the magnificent painting of Our Lady called Black Madonna is one of the most important places of religious worship in the Christian world.
