

Mr. Kranenburg returned to the Oklahoma City Department of Airports after a four-year absence by virtue of his appointment as the Director of Airports for the three city-owned airports on November 7, 2005. Mr. Kranenburg began his civilian career in aviation as an Airport Operations Officer at Will Rogers World Airport in 1993. Later he served as the General Aviation Manager managing the operations and maintenance of Wiley Post and Clarence E. Page Airport's from 1994 through 2002.
