Art Nouveau Tour

During this excursion, we will introduce you to some of the principal works of Vienna's Art Nouveau architecture, including the famous *Secession* and the *Kirche am Steinhof*. Over the years, Vienna's art and culture have become a household name, with connoisseurs from all over the world coming to admire the paintings of Gustav Klimt, Egon Schiele and Oskar Kokoschka, and the architecture of Otto Wagner, whose buildings brought about a vital change in Vienna's urban image. "*To the age its art – to art, its freedom*" was his motto, which has inspired eminent painters, architects and designers to create fascinating art, which is admired all over the world to this day.

This tour will last approximately 3 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost is your transport by deluxe coach, guide and entrance fee and tour of Kirche am Steinhof.

City Bus Tour

This tour will give you an overall impression of the most significant sights of Vienna. Then it's on to the centre of Vienna to visit one of its architectural jewels, the Schönbrunn Palace. The entrance to the former summer residence of the Hapsburg rulers gives a magnificent impression of the glorious imperial era and the highlight will be a guided tour of the Palace State Rooms.

The tour will last approximately 3 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost is transport by deluxe coach, guide, 'skip the line' entrance and private tour of Schönbrunn Palace.

City Walking and Tram Tour

Your guide will accompany you on the metro (U-Bahn) to downtown Vienna, where you will board a private, historic tram to travel along the Vienna Ringstrasse. During the 30-minute journey, you will see the Vienna State Opera House, Parliament, the City Hall and much more, while enjoying a glass of sparkling wine or a soft drink. The tram will stop at Schwedenplatz, from where you will take a walking tour through the downtown area of the city, to St. Stephen's Square and the Imperial Palace, where the tour ends and your guide will accompany you back to the ACV.

The tour will take approximately 3 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost are metro tickets, guide and a private tram ride with a drink on board.

City Walking Tour - Jewish Vienna

The history of Vienna's Jews is inextricably linked with that of the city, and dates back over 800 years. The city's many museums and memorial sites provide living reminders of this.

You will first explore this important part of Vienna with your guide and then visit the four floors of the Jewish Museum, featuring exhibitions of Jewish culture through the ages, right down to the smallest detail. In 1995, archaeologists found the walls of one of the largest medieval synagogues in Europe underneath Judenplatz – the underground excavations can be viewed inside the museum, which, together with a model of the medieval city and computer animations, give a fascinating insight into Jewish life in Vienna in the Middle Ages.

The tour will last approximately 3 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost are your metro tickets, guide and entrance fee and private tour of the Jewish Museum Vienna.

City Walking Tour with Cake and Coffee

Starting at the ACV, you will take the metro downtown with your guide. The innermost centre of Vienna is partly a pedestrian zone and, right in the heart, you will find one of its most prominent landmarks – St Stephen's Cathedral. After a private tour of the cathedral, you will continue along Kärntner Strasse, Graben and Kohlmarkt, the famous shopping streets of Vienna, and through some of the picturesque back streets, passing by the Vienna State Opera, the Imperial Palace and much more.

A highlight of the tour will be a coffee break to try the Viennese speciality coffee, *Wiener Melange* (or tea or hot chocolate) and a piece of cake.

The tour will last approximately 2.5 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost are your metro tickets, guide, entrance fee and private tour of St Stephen's Cathedral, coffee and cake.

City Walking Tour

Starting from ACV, you will take the metro downtown with your guide. The innermost centre of Vienna is partly a pedestrian zone and, right in the heart, you will find one of its most prominent landmarks – St Stephen's Cathedral. St Stephen's Cathedral is the 'mother church' of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Vienna and the seat of the Archbishop of Vienna, and was constructed on the ruins of two earlier churches.

After a private tour of the cathedral, you will continue to wander through the famous central shopping area of Vienna, as well as the historic streets which are home to the Vienna State Opera, the Imperial Palace and much more.

The tour will last approximately 3 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost are your metro tickets, guide and entrance fee and private tour of St Stephen's Cathedral.

Follow Sisi's Footsteps

Acquaint yourself with Vienna's unique history on this guided walking tour, following in the footsteps of Empress Elisabeth of Austria – affectionally known to millions as **Sisi**, her childhood nickname. In 1854, Emperor Franz Joseph married Elisabeth, who quickly became a 'fairy-tale' princess in the eyes of the public, but was tragically assassinated in Geneva in 1898. Even over a century after her death, her hold on the public imagination remains undiminished.

You will take the metro from ACV into the city centre, where your tour will start with a visit to the Imperial Crypt, the burial place of 149 Habsburgs, of which 12 were emperors and 19 empresses and queens, including Empress Elisabeth.

You will continue on to the Hofburg, official residence of Elisabeth and Franz Joseph. Nowadays, the Sisi Museum is housed in the former Imperial Palace Apartments, where numerous exhibits from her life, from her first milk tooth to the file she was assassinated with, are on display.

The tour will last approximately 3 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost are your metro tickets, entrance fees, guide and tours of the Imperial Crypt and the Sisi Museum.

The opportunity to taste various samples will bring you closer to the world full of different flavours, and you will be given some culinary tips on how to use the spices and prepare various dishes.

The tour will last approximately 3 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost are your metro tickets, guide and tour with tasting at Naschmarkt.

You will learn the basics of graffiti art, step by step, with tips and tricks from the pros. Afterwards, you can give your imagination free rein and create your own artworks.

Spanish Riding School

Vienna's world-famous Spanish Riding School is the only equestrian institution in the world which has practised classical dressage in the Renaissance tradition for more than 450 years.

During this tour, you will gain an insight into the years of training of the Lipizzaners and their riders. You will have VIP seats for the morning training session, which is accompanied by classical Viennese music, and a headset providing commentary by an official from the Riding School. Following the training session, you will have a private guided tour of the Winter Riding School, the Summer Riding School and the historic stables of the Lipizzaner stallions.

This tour will last approximately 3 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost are transport by deluxe coach, guide, VIP seats for the training session, headset and a private tour.

Vienna Woods

The hilly areas around Vienna, immortalised by Johann Strauss' famous waltz, *Tales from the Vienna Woods*, are home to numerous significant historic sites and beautiful scenery.

You will visit the Cistercian Abbey of Heiligenkreuz with its cloisters and the tomb of the last ruler of the House of Babenberg. You will also pass through Mayerling, where the lives of Crown-Prince Rudolf and Marie Vetsera ended in tragedy. After passing by the Höldrichsmühle, where Schubert composed his classic song, *The Linden Tree*, you will arrive at the Seegrotte, a former gypsum mine and now the largest subterranean lake in Europe, where you will take a boat ride through the vast cave system, before returning to the ACV.

The tour will last approximately 4 hours and will start and end at ACV; included in the tour cost are transport by deluxe coach, guide, entrance fee to Heiligenkreuz Abbey and Seegrotte boat ride.

Please be aware that there are a lot of steps at the Seegrotte.
