Synopsis

First in human gene transfer studies initiated decades ago ushered in hope that a broad range of genetic disorder modification of hematopoietic stem cells (HSCs). However, these initial human clinical trials testing gene addition unsuccessful and demonstrated that progress in both hematopoietic stem cell manipulation and genetic modification become a clinical reality. Much progress has been made in the ensuing decades, with several successful human with integrating vectors demonstrating unequivocal success. Additionally, new genetic tools for genome editing and mutation(s) among hematopoietic stem cells in genetic disorders of the hematopoietic system. This session will in first talk will describe gene therapy efforts targeting sickle cell disease. The second talk will describe gene therapy describe the current state of the art for gene editing, the holy grail for gene therapy approaches.
