This year's conference will be supporting Little Legs Dog & Cat Rescue Qld Inc (Little Legs). Little Legs is dedicated to rescuing the high number of dogs and cats who are at risk of being put to sleep in council pounds. Little Legs also assist with small dogs and cats requiring surrender by their owners.

All Little Legs' dogs and cats are placed into carefully selected foster homes, where they will remain until their forever home is found.

Little Legs' dogs and cats will have all vet work completed whilst in the care of Little Legs, including desexing, vaccinating, micro-chipping and worming/heartworm testing.

The adoption fees and donations are the only funding Little Legs receives to assist in continuing to re-home dogs and cats.

Saving animals and giving them a second chance at life is a VERY rewarding endeavour emotionally, but not financially and adoption fees alone are insufficient to take on more animals in need.

Little Legs also have a 'retirement' program that some animals are placed into due to age, medical conditions or behavioural issues.
