Louisiana and Karen Blixen Tour, 7 hrs. Saturday



Explore the beautiful North Sealand, north of Copenhagen. You leave Copenhagen and travel up the Riviera road to Elsingør. As we travel along we have a beautiful view of the Øresund Strait with the Swedish coast beyond. You will have an inside visit at Louisiana Museum which is a leading international museum of modern art. Located on the coast it strikes that rarest of balances between landscape, architecture, and art in a unique interaction that attracts visitors from around the world and makes a visit to Louisiana something special throughout the year.

You will also see Karen Blixen's private home. The rooms are almost exactly as Karen Blixen decorated and arranged them, giving a vivid impression of the writer's day-to-day surroundings. Some of the furnitures came from the farm in Africa, including Denys Finch Hatton's favorite chair and the chest that Karen Blixen's steward, Farah, gave her. A number of the old stoves in the rooms came from Danish manor houses once owned by Karen Blixen's relatives.

Smushi is a combination of sushi and Danish smørrebrød (open sandwich).

Christiansborg, and a different perspective of Copenhagen, 4.5 hrs. Monday



If you want to see the different perspectives of Copenhagen, this is the tour.

First you will experience Christiansborg, where the Danish Parliament is based. The magnificent halls and rooms at Christiansborg is also used by the Royal Family for representative purposes.

Christiania has more than thirty years of history with long and tangled battles, victories and defeats. Christiania covers an area of more than 85 acres and houses, almost one thousand inhabitants, but every year, more than a million people visit the Freetown. Some of them use Christiania almost every day, others pay a quick visit to the village in the middle of Copenhagen. Christiania is thus one of the greatest tourist attractions in Copenhagen, and abroad it is a well-known “brand” for the progressive and liberated Danish lifestyle. Many Danish businesses and organizations also use Christiania as a show place for their foreign friends and guests. The purpose is to show something Danish that cannot be found anywhere else in the world. People from far and near are still attracted by the Freetown's magic mixture of anarchy and love.

At the end of the tour, you will meet a homeless (guide), he or she will take you through some of Copenhagen and tell about how it is being homeless in Copenhagen, where do they sleep, and what do they do during the day in Copenhagen.
