## WSU Course Information

Pre-License training is for pesticide applicators, consultants, and dealers who would like to obtain a license. All exam categories will be available on testing day and administered by the Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA). **This WSU training is conducted in English** and focuses on eight of the 26 WSDA exams. Not all exam topics are covered. Courses do not cover aquatic, public health, seed treatment, soil fumigation, Pest Control Operator (PCO), or Structural Pest Inspector (SPI) unless otherwise specified.

All license types should attend both days of training except for Dealer Manager. Dealer Managers need to register for Day 1 only and return for the exam on the afternoon of Day 2.

If you hold a valid pesticide applicator license and are interested in adding a category, only attend the day that the category-specific information is covered.

If you want to review the material for the Laws & Safety Exam, also register for November 30. Weed Management will be reviewed on the morning of December 1, and the WSDA exam session will be offered that afternoon.
