



Media Policies and Information

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Media Registration:

All members of the media are required to apply for accreditation. Registrations are not transferrable.

Registered journalists will be able to attend the main conference program that begins Monday, October 15.

Picking Up Media Credentials:

General Policies/Restrictions:

- All India Energy Forum by CERAWeek sessions listed on the main conference program (<http://indiaenergy.ceraweek.com>) – with the exception of those listed as private – are open to journalists unless otherwise stated.
- For lunch and dinner sessions ONLY – Due to space limitations, journalists are not permitted inside the ballrooms for lunch and dinner sessions. Journalists will be able to watch live video of those sessions in the Media Work Room. Meals for journalists will be provided in the Media Work Room.
- Any sessions that are CLOSED to news media will be listed in the Media Work Room

Audio Policies/Restrictions

- Audio recording devices are permitted unless otherwise stated. A mult box is available in the Media Work Room (Sheesh Mahal).
- Using short clips or sound bytes of India Energy Forum by CERAWeek sessions in news reports is permitted.
- However, audio recordings of India Energy Forum by CERAWeek sessions or events *in their entirety* are not to be publicly distributed without express written permission from IHS Markit.

Video Policies/Restrictions

- No video recording of any kind is permitted inside India Energy Forum by CERAWeek sessions without express written permission from IHS Markit.
- On-camera taped interviews are permitted outside of conference sessions.
- Live video broadcast on-site at the Taj Palace is prohibited without express written permission from IHS Markit.

Still Photography

- Still photography by credentialed media is permitted in all conference sessions that are open to media unless otherwise stated.
- Still photography inside the ballroom during lunches and dinners is permitted during the on-stage presentations only. Photographers should refrain from taking pictures prior to the beginning of the on-stage presentations.

IHS Markit requires that proper attribution be given in all news reports related to its events.
