

GENEVA PRE/POST TOUR



Discover Geneva and surroundings

Embedded between nearby Alpine peaks and the hilly terrain of the Jura, the French-speaking city of Geneva lies in the bay where the Rhone leaves Lake Geneva. With its humanitarian tradition and cosmopolitan flair, the European seat of the UNO and headquarters of the Red Cross is known as the “capital of peace”.

The symbol of the «world’s smallest metropolis» is the “Jet d’eau” – a fountain with a 140-metre-high water jet at the periphery of Lake Geneva. Most of the large hotels and many restaurants are situated on the right-hand shore of the lake. The old town, the heart of Geneva with the shopping and business quarter, holds sway over the left-hand shore. Quays, lakeside promenades, countless parks, lively side streets in the old town and elegant shops invite guests to stroll. Geneva is Switzerland’s most international city, as it is where the European seat of the UNO is based. Even the International Red Cross directs its humanitarian campaigns from here. The «Horloge Fleuri», the large flower clock in the “Jardin Anglais” (English Garden), is a world-renowned symbol of the Geneva watch industry.

Walking Tour of Carouge

Patek Philippe Museum



Located in the heart of Plainpalais since 2001, this museum invites you to discover the origins of this accessory through its magnificent collections of Swiss, Genevan and European watchmaking and enamels from the sixteenth to the twentieth century.

ACTIVITIES 2/5

Excursion to Mont Salève

Geneva has its very own mountain... in France! Just across the French border is a cable car that carries you to an altitude of 1,100 meters in less than five minutes. Mont Salève is an immense playground for sports lovers. You can go paragliding, climbing, mountain biking, trekking... or cross-country skiing in winter. Nature lovers will enjoy the fresh air, the fauna and flora and the stunning vista of Geneva and its shores, the lake and the Jura Mountains. On the south-east side, you can enjoy a view of the Alps with the Mont-Blanc massif. Food lovers can meet at the restaurant.



Excursion to Lausanne



In Lausanne, during a 02.00hrs city tour, you will discover the second-largest city on Lake Geneva, which combines a dynamic commercial town with the locality of a holiday resort. The capital of the canton of Vaud is also a lively university and convention town. Sports and culture are given a high profile in the Olympic capital.

Excursion to Annecy

Tucked away at the edge of the lake with a mountain backdrop, Annecy, the capital of Haute-Savoie, is renowned for its wonderful environment and high quality of life. In an outstanding position downstream from the lake, it has retained its architectural and historic heritage, restored its old quarter, restored the lake water's transparency through work which is often held up as an example and developed its canals to which it owes its name of the "Venice of the Alps".

Regular excursion to Chamonix

A must! Every day, all year. Mountain resorts at the foot of the majestic Mont-Blanc, highest peak of Europe (4807m). Good trip? A must see!!! Passport necessary to cross the French border!

A 90 minutes drive by bus through the picturesque Arve Valley takes us from Geneva to Chamonix, one of the most famous mountain villages at the foot of the remarkable and majestic Mont-Blanc, the highest peak of Europe (4807 m./15.771 ft).



Regular excursion to Gruyeres and Golden train



There is no stronger temptation than the chocolate smell! Journey through chocolate, cheese and wine tradition with tasting the most famous of Swiss delicacies.

Start with the Chocolate factory Maison Cailler, understand the history of chocolate, how they make it and taste as much as you like. At noon, you will reach the top of the Moléson Mountain to a hand making cheese factory. You will taste the famous Gruyeres and Vacherin Fribourgeois, two cheeses mixed for our typical Swiss fondue.

Admire breathtaking landscapes of Gruyères. At the top of the hill, breathe pure mountain air and hear cowbells

in the pasturelands. Spend some free time wondering in the village from the middle-age. After that, relax in a comfortable ride aboard the famous Golden Express train overlooking magnificent views over Lake Lemman. Taste Swiss wine produced in the region classified by UNESCO Lavaux. A day full of taste and unforgettable experiences.

Regular excursion to Montreux / Lausanne and Golden train

LAUSANNE, picturesque town built on hills and cultural city. Discover the Old city of Lausanne on a guided walk in the medieval Old Town. Then your tour includes the visit of the Olympic Museum. Just before lunch, you will take a ride in the protected site by UNESCO, the Lavaux region to discover the beautiful Vaud countryside, a vineyard region.

The emblem of the city is the statue of Freddy Mercury.
